Prerequisites

Prerequisite: FREN 251 or three years high school French

Course Description

This course is a continuation of French 251. There will be emphasis on aural and oral practices. Also, there will be a study of French contemporary life and literature. There will be instructional aids included. This course emphasizes reading French literature and will culminate in the writing of a report on a piece of French literature. Several pieces of French literature will be read during the course. The primary purpose of this course is to have the students read and comprehend French literature at a fluent intermediate level. This course is a satisfier course for the Global Studies Degree Designation.

Course Outcomes

In order to evidence success in this course, the students will be able to:

1. Identify the six tenses in French: present, simple past, future, imperfect, conditional and subjunctive
2. Demonstrate usage of intermediate vocabulary
3. Identify vocabulary related to major unit studies
4. Memorize verb conjugations and usages
5. Identify various source materials used for historical research
6. Demonstrate the ability to write short essays in the target language using the six aforementioned tenses
7. Demonstrate the ability to use the target language in an intermediate level conversation and/or reading material
8. Demonstrate the ability to research French related historical figures and subject matters to compile a research paper written in the target language
9. Demonstrate his/her general knowledge of French culture as well as some French historical periods
10. Demonstrate the ability to read an entire novel in the target language and then compile the information about the novel into a report in that language
