



## **IMPORTANT NOTICE REGARDING THE SENIOR CITIZENS SCHOLARSHIP**

At its regular meeting on June 22, 2009, the Monroe County Community College Board of Trustees voted to change the college's policy on the Senior Citizens Scholarship.

**Effective Fall Semester 2009, 50 percent of tuition charges for credit and non-credit classes will be waived for Monroe County residents age 60 or older.** Previously, 100 percent of the tuition charges were waived.

As they have been in the past, registration, technology, lab, special fees and credit-by-exam fees are not subject to the waiver and are the responsibility of the student.

MCCC regrets any difficulties that our senior citizen students may face as a result of this policy change. The need to change was driven by budget constraints the college is facing due to Michigan's recession economy, which has reduced state aid to community colleges and funding from local taxes. We are confident MCCC will continue to be one of the best values for higher education in southeast Michigan and northwest Ohio.
