- Visit the Royal College of Physicians, a governing body of the British medical profession since 1518
- Walk through London's medical district, taking in renowned institutions including University College Hospital, the General Medical Council

Visit the Wellcome Collection, a museum dedicated to medical artifacts and original artworks exploring "ideas about the connections between medicine, life, and art"

Visit an old operating theater, which got their start as a way for medical students to learn and observe techniques during the early history of medicine in England
