## FREE MCCC In-County Tuition Available for Frontline Workers

- 2. Apply to Monroe County Community College at www.monroeccc.edu/apply.
- 3. Submit your FAFSA at www.fafsa.gov. The staff of the Financial Aid Office at MCCC are available to provide assistance in completing the FAFSA.

The amount of assistance will be determined after all Pell Grant or other federal or state grant awards have been determined and applied.
