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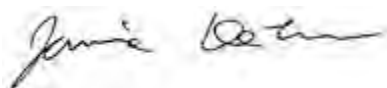
Summary

Enrollment at Monroe County Community College (MCCC) continues on a downward trend for a fifth year. Fall 2015 headcount was 3482, 8.3% less than Fall 2014 enrollment ($N = 3192$). Credit hour count decreased at a similar rate, 8.7%. Data provided by Michigan Association of Collegiate Registrars and Admissions Officers (MACRAO) indicated that compared to the 26 other Michigan community colleges, MCCC's headcount decline was slightly higher than average (5.2%), as was its credit hour decline (6.1% average).

MCCC captured 22% of the county's high school market share. Demographic categories with the most significant declines in enrollment were out-of-state, age 30+, first time in any college, and full-time students. While at first glance enrollment appears to have declined considerably among minority groups, a larger proportion of (Caucasian) students reported their ethnicity/race this year. The dual enrollment headcount ($N = 477$) remained virtually the same as 2014 ($N = 481$) despite the decrease in overall enrollment. When interpreting the Fall-to-Fall change in enrollment statistics, please keep in mind that if all groups reacted similarly, the baseline enrollment decline for each group would be 8.3%.
