This course focuses on helping health sciences students learn and use the skills of successful college students by providing an open forum for discussion that promotes self-awareness and a sense of belonging and purpose. Students will learn resilience and enhance their readiness for an education in health sciences. Enhanced readiness will be achieved through various assignments encompassing assessment and practice of skills used in health sciences such as math, anatomy and physiology, and medical terminology, as well as classroom, study, and test-taking skills. Students will obtain a Certificate of Completion validating readiness for the next level of health sciences curriculum. This course is appropriate for any student accepted or trying to be accepted into a health sciences program.
