Consistently over the past three Fall semesters, dual enrolled students earned between 10 to 20% more A's than their not dual enrolled counterparts. Also consistent over the past three Fall semesters, dual enrolled students withdrew from fewer course than their not dual enrolled counterparts (6 to 7% fewer).
