There is inconsistent distribution of most letter grade assignment, especially A, among all location formats which is likely due to variation in the overall range of possible grades that are assigned. For example, no withdrawal, pass, fail, or other none-letter grades are assigned in direct college, off-campus and blended courses, with the exception of a few withdrawals in blended courses.

Comparison of online versus on campus courses reveals consistent grade distribution, with 2.7% more withdrawals occurring in online courses.
