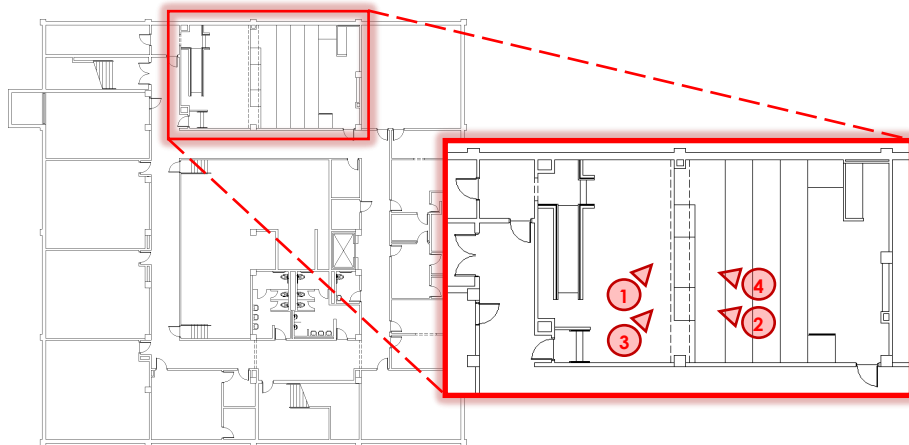


Building Report | Little Theater Renovations

This will be the final report for this project as it is complete and this area is in use already this semester. There are a few punch list items left for the contractor to correct, and a few programming issues to clear up with the new A/V and lighting systems, but other than that this space is working out great for the College. The Little Theater will not only be a great asset for the College, but the community in whole. The Humanities/Social Sciences Division is in the midst of utilizing it for regular classes, but is busy creating a line up cultural enrichment events to host in this space. To bring this project to a close I have included some before and after shots to help everyone realize just what a needed renovation this project was and what a wonderful outcome we ended up with.



Photos #1 and #3 show the difference in the stage area of the theater. There the curtains were torn and fall off their rods and hangers. The lighting was inadequate and/or non-functional. There was permanent project system, and now there is a state of the art rear project and screen. There are also new ramps to help this space meet current ADA standards (handicap access). Photos #2 and #4 show the difference in the seating area of the theater. There are all new seats to replace the old dilapidated chairs. We have an all new A/V booth with all new equipment including a new sound and light board. The theater in general has new ceilings, acoustical treatments, and LED lighting. The seating area was also updated to meet ADA standards.
