

Building Report | Unisex Restroom/Private Room Project

The following are pictures from the week ending in 10.22.21 in regards to the Unisex Restroom/Private Room Project located in the Student Services/Administration Building. This is the first report for this project which is on schedule for completion around mid-December. This is fifth unisex restroom we are installing on campus, and the second private room. Our goal is to have one unisex restroom on each floor of each building. The private room is our second on campus and we are aiming towards having a minimum of one per building. The unisex restrooms help achieve many goals including meeting ADA compliance, providing gender neutral facilities, etc. The private rooms allow us to have spaces for lactation, prayer and meditation, privacy, a calming space for those who need them, etc. Both are all vital pieces of the overall millage renovations plans that better allow us to serve the many and varying needs of our students, staff, and visitors.



The top-right photo shows the contractors having exposed areas of the existing wall and floor slab so as to again access to existing plumbing infrastructure. Having access to these systems will allow the new plumbing to be connected into existing systems.

The top-left photo shows the completed demolition of the old spline ceiling system in the area where the new restroom and private room will be located.



The bottom-left photo shows the start of the wall framing being erected for both the new unisex restroom and private room. Looking at this photo the new unisex restroom will be on the left with the door off the south face of the room. The new private room would then be on the right with the door off of the east wall facing towards the 173 conference rooms.
