**MCCC AWARDS THE ROY TURNER SCHOLARSHIP**



MONROE, Mich. – Monroe County Community College has awarded the Roy Turner Scholarship to **Nicholas Spicer**. The scholarship is to be used for tuition, books, and fees.

To be eligible for this scholarship, a student must be a Monroe County resident and a Monroe County firefighter or the child or grandchild of a local (Monroe County) firefighter.
