THE FOUNDATION AT MCCC AWARDS THE DISABLED AMERICAN VETERANS CHAPTER 137 SCHOLARSHIP

MONROE, Mich. – The Foundation Monroe County Community College has awarded the D.A.V. Chapter 137 Scholarship to **Grace Fisher** and **Dakota Roberts**. The D.A.V. Chapter 137 Scholarship was established at The Foundation at MCCC to provide scholarship support for a MCCC student who is a disabled veteran, an honorably discharged veteran or a dependent of a veteran. Each \$500 scholarship is to be used for tuition, fees, books and supplies.

Fisher of Petersburg is a 2017 graduate of Summerfield High School. She is studying nursing while attending MCCC. She is the daughter of Jeff and Sheri Fisher.

Roberts of Monroe is a 2019 graduate of Monroe High School. He is pursuing a graphic design degree at MCCC. He is a member of Stewart Road Church of God where he is in charge of the video team and is responsible for a portion of the graphics. Dakota is the son of Rich and Kristy.

To be eligible for this scholarship, a student must be a resident of Monroe County, Michigan, and a United States citizen, must be a veteran or the child of a veteran, the veteran must have received an honorable discharge and submit a copy of their DD-214, have a 2.5 grade point average or higher. Financial need may be considered in awarding the scholarship.
