"What the Eves Don't

See" is the story of how Hanna-Attisha, along with a team of researchers, parents, friends and community leaders discovered that the children of Flint were being exposed to lead poisoning and how they exposed that truth to the world.

One Book, One Community of Monroe County, modeled after a program developed by the American Library Association, promoted reading by recommending a compelling text that links community members in conversation through group readings, discussions and other events.
