| Course Description | An introductory course to acquaint the student with the theory and application of statistical methods that are used in business, health care, and the natural and social sciences. Topics include graphical representations of data, measures of central tendency, probability and probability distributions, sampling distributions, correlation and regression, inferences for categorical and quantitative data, confidence intervals and hypothesis testing. Emphasis is on interpretation and evaluation of statistical results. Calculators and statistical software will be utilized. | WHERE DO STUDENTS START | MyLab Statistics Student Registration Instructions To register for Statistics: Go to pearsonmylabandmastering.com. Under Register, click Student. Enter your instructor's course ID: vallade71516 and click Continue. Sign in with an existing Pearson account or create an account. If you have used a Pearson platform (for example, MyLab Statistics or MyLab Psychology), enter your Pearson username and password. Click Sign in. If you do not have a Pearson account, click Create. Write down your new Pearson username and password to help you remember them. Select an option to access your instructor's online course: Use the access code that came with your textbook or that you purchased separately from the bookstore. | Student Login Information | To login to Brightspace, E-mail, or WebPal , go to <u>www.monroeccc.edu</u> and click on CURRENT STUDENTS on the menu bar, then click on Brightspace, email, or WebPal from the links that appear on the left side of the screen. Brightspace - Login to Brightspace using your unique MCCC WebPal username (i.e., the first part of your MCCC email address) and 7-digit student ID number for your password (or whatever password you use for your MCCC college email account). You should be able to access Brightspace 24 hours after registering for a course. Courses are not available in Brightspace until the first day of the semester. E-mail - Your email address is your MyWebPal user name followed by @my.monroeccc.edu (i.e. jsmith12345@my.monroeccc.edu). Your password is your seven-digit student ID number (including leading zeros). WebPal - You need a WebPAL user ID and a password to access WebPAL. | | digit birthdate (i.e. January 1, 1970 = 010170). After logging on the first time, WebPAL will ask you to change your password. If you are a returning student and can't remember your password, click on "What's My Password?" on the WebPAL home page, then choose "Reset my password." If you have an e-mail address on file, WebPAL will send you a new password. |
