RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR AWARDING C. ERNEST READ SCHOLARSHIPS

I. General

- 1. Revenues for the scholarships will be provided by interest from the C. Ernest Read Trust.
- 2. A scholarship will not exceed \$1,000, divided equally between the fall and winter semesters.

II. Qualifications of Applicants

Applicants must meet the following qualifications:

- 1. Have a cumulative MCCC grade point average of 2.5 or better by the end of the winter semester of the freshman year.
- 2. Have accumulated a minimum of 24 credit hours at MCCC by the end of the winter semester of the freshman year.
- 3. Be an active participant in a recognized College organization, helping to promote College ideals and improve campus life for other students.

III. Application Procedures

- 1. Applicants must complete an application form and submit it typewritten to the Financial Aid Office.
- 2. The application form must be signed by three (3) staff members (faculty and/or administrators).
- 3. Applications must be submitted no later than the first day school is in session after February 28.

IV. Award Procedures

- 1. The Financial Aid Office will select the scholarship winners and alternates by April 1. The Financial Aid Office will notify the winners and any alternates.
- 2. Finalists may be requested to appear for a personal interview.

V. Criteria for Keeping the Scholarship

- 1. Recipients must maintain active membership in a recognized College organization or activity during the time of the scholarship.
- 2. Recipients must be enrolled for a minimum of 12 credit hours in both the fall and winter semesters.
- 3. Recipients must maintain a cumulative 2.5 grade point average.
- 4. Any exceptions to these rules and regulations must be approved in writing by the Vice President of Student and Information Services.
