POLICY CONCERNING GUEST SPEAKERS

- 1. In keeping with the concept of academic freedom, the campus shall be used to foster intelligent and rational discussion of every variety of idea.
- 2. As a limited public forum, Monroe County Community College neither endorses, adopts nor advocates any particular religious or political viewpoint. Use of Monroe County Community College facilities, as regulated by the Board of Trustees, is provided as a community service and as required by governing law.
- 3. Speakers shall be held solely responsible for the views they express.
- 4. Only community groups and recognized student organizations may be permitted to use campus facilities.
- 5. Any action to be taken against speakers for what they say during their presentations on campus shall remain with regular civil authorities who administer federal and state law.
- 6. Student organizations shall be disciplined accordingly for any violation of this policy.
- 7. All speakers shall be scheduled in compliance with College procedures 6.18(a).
