PROCEDURES FOR ELIGIBILITY FOR MAJOR DONOR PLAQUE

A major donor is a person or company who has contributed a minimum of \$10,000 to the College. This would include any donated money to the College even if the specific use was designated. This could include estates, endowment scholarships, restricted scholarships, and gifts either restricted or unrestricted.

Guidelines are as follows:

- 1. A minimum of \$10,000 will be required for plaque eligibility.
- 2. Equipment donations will not be included in consideration.
- 3. The \$10,000 could be a cumulative amount. Records will be kept on a cumulative basis for all donors.
- 4. The donation could be individual or company contributions. However, a memorial scholarship fund with many small donations by different people would not be considered for the Major Donor Plaque.
