

Practical Nursing Program Student Achievement Data

The MCCC Practical Nursing Program is committed to continuous program improvement. Part of the process is to monitor the achievements of program graduates. The following data categories are used to assess overall *Program Performance Outcomes*.

• NCLEX- PN Pass Rates:

- Once a student has completed education/training, she/he must pass a state licensing exam to become a fully licensed practical nurse. The exam is called the NCLEX-PN.
- NCLEX stands for "National Council Licensure Exam".
- MCCC's goal is to be at or above 80% for all first-time test-takers.

Program Completion Rates:

Effective 2021:

- The expected level of achievement (ELA) for 100% completion rate for the PN program is 50% of all students who begin the first nursing course and can no longer receive a 100% tuition refund for the first nursing course will complete the program within three semesters.
- The expected level of achievement (ELA) for ultimate completion for the PN Program is 60% of all students who begin the first nursing course and can no longer receive a 100% tuition refund for the first nursing course will ultimately complete the program.
