

AAS-Nursing Program PN to RN Option Student Achievement Data

The MCCC AAS-Nursing Program, PN to RN option is committed to continuous program improvement. Part of the process is to monitor the achievements of option graduates. The following data categories are used to assess overall *Program Performance Outcomes*.

NCLEX-RN Pass Rates:

- Once a nurse has completed education/training, she/he must pass a licensing exam to become a fully licensed nurse. The exam is called the NCLEX-RN.
- o NCLEX stands for "National Council Licensure Exam".
- o MCCC's goal is to be at or above 80% for all first-time test-takers.
