

CHECKLIST FOR THE REGISTERED NURSING (AAS-Nursing) PROGRAM

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

APPLICATIONS MUST BE SUBMITTED THROUGH ONLINE PORTAL.

See application directions available at www.monroecc.edu/rn.

Application windows:

Program	Application Opens	Application Closes End of Business Day
Registered Nursing (RN), Winter start	February 1	Third Monday in May
Registered Nursing (RN), Fall start	July 1	First Monday in October

Note: Students accepted from the May application deadline will start nursing courses the following winter semester.

Students accepted from the October application deadline will start nursing courses the following fall semester.

Both application cycles allow students one semester to concentrate on non-nursing required courses prior to starting the nursing sequence.

Students are strongly encouraged to review the *Registered Nurse Program Class Selection Criteria* and *Student Information Handbook* prior to applying to the AAS-Nursing program. Both are available at: www.monroecc.edu/rn.

- Accepted student to MCCC.
- High school transcript or GED scores and all *official* college transcripts submitted to the MCCC Registrar's Office by the application deadline. **Students new to MCCC must meet with an MCCC Counselor in order to have their college/transfer transcripts evaluated by the Registrar's Office.**
- English/Reading Requirement***: Students must have completed one of the 3 options below.
 - A. Have placement test scores that qualify you to enroll in **ENGL 151 (English Composition I)**
 - B. Completed/passed **ENGL 090 and/or RDG 090**
 - C. Completed/passed **ENGL 151 (English Composition I)** or higher level English course, or a transfer equivalent course.

* MELAB (80 percentile) or IBN TOEFL (79-80) tests may be required to show proof of English language proficiency for individuals whose native language is not English.
- Math Requirement**: Students must have completed one of the following options.
 - A. Completed/passed MATH 092 (Beginning Algebra) or higher level math course or a transfer equivalent course
 - B. Have placement test scores equivalent to or higher than the MATH 092 level.
- ATI TEAS**: Minimum Overall Score of 60 on the ATI TEAS nursing entrance exam (visit <https://www.monroecc.edu/mccc-ati-teas> for more information). Official transcript must be sent to MCCC by the application deadline.
- Cumulative grade point average of 2.7 or higher from the most recent academic institution attended (high school, college, university) deemed appropriate by MCCC.
- Certifications/Licensure/Degrees (*if applicable - See selection criteria for qualifying items - **NOT REQUIRED TO APPLY***)
