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AAS-Nursing Program Student Achievement Data

The MCCC AAS-Nursing Program is committed to continuous program improvement. Part of the process is to monitor the achievements of program graduates. The following data categories are used to assess overall *Program Performance Outcomes*.

- NCLEX-RN Pass Rates:
 - Once a nurse has completed education/training, she/he must pass a state licensing exam to become a fully licensed nurse. The exam is called the NCLEX-RN.
 - NCLEX stands for “National Council Licensure Exam”.
 - MCCC’s goal is to be at or above 80% for all first-time test-takers.

 - Defined as, “The percentage of each nursing cohort that completes the nursing program within six semesters (150% of the prescribed time)”
 - MCCC’s goal is to maintain a program completion rate at or above 60%.
