

## **AAS-Nursing Program Student Achievement Data**

The MCCC AAS-Nursing Program is committed to continuous program improvement. Part of the process is to monitor the achievements of program graduates. The following data categories are used to assess overall *Program Performance Outcomes*.

## • NCLEX-RN Pass Rates:

- Once a nurse has completed education/training, she/he must pass a state licensing exam to become a fully licensed nurse. The exam is called the NCLEX-RN.
- o NCLEX stands for "National Council Licensure Exam".
- o MCCC's goal is to be at or above 80% for all first-time test-takers.
