NCLEX-RN Pass Rates:

- Once a nurse has completed education/training, she/he must pass a state licensing exam to become a fully licensed nurse. The exam is called the NCLEX-RN.
- NCLEX stands for "National Council Licensure Exam".
- o MCCC's goal is to be at or above 80% for all first-time test-takers.
