

MCCC-EMU CONCURRENT ENROLLMENT OPTION

Beginning in the fall of 2019, MCCC will be partnering with Eastern Michigan University (EMU) to offer a unique program that allows students to simultaneously complete an Associate of Applied Science in Nursing (AAS) degree *and* a Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) degree. Enrollment in the concurrent enrollment option is not required to participate in the MCCC RN program. Students interested in participating in this option must be accepted into the RN (AAS) program at MCCC. Seats in the concurrent enrollment option are limited to 16 students annually; 8 students for the fall start cohort and 8 students for the winter start cohort. In the event there are more students interested in the option than seats available, acceptance into each cohort will be determined according to points earned on the initial application to the MCCC RN (AAS) program. Students interested in applying to this concurrent enrollment option should submit the MCCC-EMU Concurrent Enrollment Option Verification/Application form to the MCCC Admission's Office or MCCC Health Sciences Division Office with their application for the traditional MCCC RN program and by the deadline of the application period in which they apply.

In addition to MCCC program and degree requirements, students enrolled in the collaboration agreement must complete extra coursework required under the Michigan Transfer Agreement (MTA), as well as complete EMU program requirements in order to earn the BSN degree. Courses required to satisfy the MTA may be taken at either MCCC or EMU. Some of the courses may also apply to program and/or degree requirements at MCCC. The table below outlines extra courses that will be required to complete the BSN degree. Some of these courses may also satisfy general education requirements at MCCC.

* Satisfies EMU's Perspectives on a Diverse World. If ANTHR 152 is not taken for this agreement, students may reference the EMU [general education transfer guide](#) for other courses that can meet the requirement.

Note: Candidates must satisfy all the all the requirements for their Associate of Applied Science in Nursing, Registered and their Bachelor of Science in Nursing - Completion from Eastern Michigan University at each institution respectively. Students will receive advising from MCCC and EMU to assure all requirements are met prior to starting the program.

Courses must be completed with a “C” or better in order to earn the BSN degree and all courses must be completed by the end of the last BSN nursing course in order to graduate from EMU on time. **Students are strongly encouraged to work with an academic advisor to determine likelihood of program completion and develop a plan for course completion that is realistic and will result in timely completion of the degree.** Students must take the required nursing courses in the order and semesters prescribed on the curriculum plans provided below. Any deviation will result in dismissal from the EMU collaborative option. Policies related to progression in MCCC’s program will apply. Students will be eligible for NCLEX-testing and licensure upon completion of the MCCC RN (AAS) program.

The curriculum plan for each cohort start includes only required pre-requisites, major requirements, and the order of completing these courses at both institutions. MTA, required non-nursing courses for the BSN degree, and EMU general education courses are *not* included and may be completed during a semester of the student’s discretion. A MCCC-EMU Concurrent Enrollment Option Advising Sheet is available to students in the Admissions Office and Health Sciences Division Office to assist with planning and course tracking. The Advising Sheet lists all courses required to complete the MCCC AAS (RN) degree and the EMU BSN-Completion degree.

The MCCC/EMU Collaborative Agreement requires 124 total credit hours of instruction to earn the BSN degree. MCCC’s RN (AAS) program is accredited by the Accreditation Commission in Education in Nursing (ACEN). EMU’s BSN program is accredited by the Commission on Collegiate Nursing Education (CCNE).
