

MCCC-UM-Flint CONCURRENT ENROLLMENT OPTION

Beginning in the fall of 2021, MCCC will be partnering with University of Michigan-Flint (UM-Flint) to offer a unique program that allows students to simultaneously complete an Associate of Applied Science in Nursing (AAS) degree *and* a Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) degree. Enrollment in the concurrent enrollment option is not required to participate in the MCCC RN program. Students interested in participating in this option must be accepted into the RN (AAS) program at MCCC. Students interested in applying to this concurrent enrollment option should submit the MCCC-UM-Flint

In addition to MCCC program and degree requirements, students enrolled in the collaboration agreement must complete extra coursework required for general education requirements at UM-Flint, as well as complete UM-Flint program requirements in order to earn the BSN degree. Courses required to satisfy UM-Flint's general education may be taken at either MCCC or UM-Flint. Some of the courses may also apply to program and/or degree requirements at MCCC. The table below outlines extra courses that will be required to complete the BSN degree. Some of these courses may also satisfy general education requirements at MCCC.

Students will receive 15 University of Michigan-Flint credits once they pass their NCLEX and complete at least 1 semester at UM-Flint. These 15 credits can be used towards the overall 120 college credits needed for the degree and the senior rule (last 30 credits need to stay at UM-Flint). Please make sure to work closely with a UM-Flint and MCCC advisor.

Michigan Transfer Agreement (MTA)

Students who transfer from a Michigan institution with a completed MTA will have a majority of their UM-Flint general education requirements satisfied. A completed MTA will satisfy the following UM-Flint General Education Requirements: First Year Experience, English composition, Humanities, Finance and Quantitative Literacy, Natural Science, and Social Science. Students who do not complete the entire MTA will receive a course by course evaluation of their transfer credit. For more information visit UM-Flint Admissions at www.umflint.edu/admissions. 1. Remaining requirements (general education & nursing curriculum) may be completed through UM-Flint.
2. Transfer students must earn a minimum of 30 semester hours at the University of Michigan-Flint, overall of 120 college credits (including transfer & UM-Flint credits) and the last 30 credits must be at UM-Flint. The 15 credits for the NCLEX can be used toward these rules.
3. The nursing curriculum is 33-35 credits and a C (75%) or higher is required for the nursing curriculum.
4. Catalog requirements are subject to change on an annual basis and students are required to follow the catalog under which they are admitted.
5. Transfer credit is subject to change. Please speak with an UM-Flint representative before taking any additional coursework and to review your transcripts.

Students are strongly encouraged to work with an academic advisor to determine likelihood of program completion and develop a plan for course completion that is realistic and will result in timely completion of the degree. Policies related to progression in MCCC's program will apply. Students will be eligible for NCLEX-testing and licensure upon completion of the MCCC RN (AAS) program.

The curriculum plan for each cohort start includes only required prerequisites, major requirements, and the order of completing these courses at both institutions. MTA, required non-nursing courses for the BSN degree, and UM-Flint general education courses are *not* included and may be completed during a semester of the student's discretion. A MCCC-UM-Flint Concurrent Enrollment Option Advising Sheet is available to students in the Admissions Office and Health Sciences Division Office to assist with planning and course tracking. The Advising Sheet lists all courses required to complete the MCCC AAS (RN) degree and the UM-Flint BSN-Completion degree.

The MCCC/UM-Flint Collaborative Agreement requires 120 total credit hours of instruction to earn the BSN degree. MCCC's RN (AAS) program is accredited by the Accreditation Commission in Education in Nursing (ACEN). UM-Flint's BSN program is accredited by the Commission on Collegiate Nursing Education (CCNE).
