

Professional Licensure Disclosure Respiratory Therapy

Monroe County Community College is regionally accredited by Higher Learning Commission. The Respiratory Therapy program is accredited by the Commission on Accreditation for Respiratory Care (COARC).

This program is designed to meet the educational requirements for respiratory therapists in Michigan and Ohio. Upon completion, students are eligible for CRT and RRT examinations in these states. MCCC has not determined if the Respiratory Therapy program at MCCC meets the state education requirements in any other state or U.S. Territory.
