Narrative

On Tuesday 12/7 2021 R/o received an email from the Principal of MCMC, Robert Kreuger regarding an incident that occurred on Monday during the 5th hour of school.

Mr. Kreuger advised that on Monday 12/6/21 during the 5th hour a MCMC student, [REDACTED] [REDACTED] asked a fellow student "how long did you want to live?", to which the other student, [REDACTED] [REDACTED] replied "why?" [REDACTED] then stated "because [REDACTED] was thinking about murder."

Mr. Kreuger explained this incident was not brought to his attention until approximately 7pm the evening of 12/6/21. Once this was brought to his attention, Mr. Kreuger contacted the student that was asked the questions, [REDACTED], and spoke with [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] parents. Mr. Kreuger then contacted [REDACTED] [REDACTED], [REDACTED], and spoke with [REDACTED] regarding the incident. At the end of that conversation, Mr. Kreuger advised that [REDACTED] would not be

allowed back to school until a more thorough investigation could be completed by the ISD. [REDACTED] understood and advised [REDACTED] would inform [REDACTED].

At the end of that discussion, Mr. Kreuger contacted the Monroe County Sheriff Department and advised them of what had transpired. Deputy Grahams report, with redactions, is included in this file.

Deputy Graham met with [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] did remember parts of the conversation; however, [REDACTED] did not recall making any reference to "murder". [REDACTED] commented that [REDACTED] was joking and did not have any intentions of harming anyone.

Deputy Graham submitted his report for review by the prosecutor's office for threats against [REDACTED].

On 12/8/2021 a meeting was held with Mr. Robert Kreuger, Principal of the MCMC, Ms Megan Hickey, Dean of Students for MCMC, Ms. Michelle Jenkins, MCMC Counselor and Ms Lisa Montrief, Assistant Superintendent. The College members were Dr. Kojo Quartey President of the College, Mrs S. Wetzel VP of Administration, Steve Yeary Safety Services Officer and R/o. All parties discussed the incident and the priorities of both the MCMC and the MCCC. Plans to have [REDACTED] return to the campus were discussed and would be held in abeyance until further information from the court system

On 12/15/2021 R/o learned that the Prosecutor's office, there would be no charges brought against [REDACTED]. Copy of email included in [REDACTED] file.

A return to school plan was created for [REDACTED] through the ISD and approved by Dr. Quartey. Plan also attached to file.

[REDACTED] returned to the campus on Monday, 12/20/2021.
