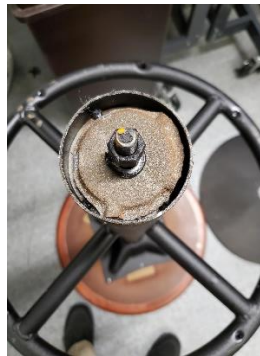

**Narrative**

On December 10<sup>th</sup> R/o noted a photograph of a damaged Hi-Top table on the Safety Services cell phone. R/o noted there was no mention or documentation reporting the damaged table.

Later in the afternoon a review of the atrium cameras determined the cause of the damaged table. Four Monroe County Middle College students climb onto the table and rock it until it breaks from the base. The students then set the table on its top and leave the area.

R/o contacted Robert Krueger, Principal of MCMC and asked for his assistance in identifying the students involved. Mr. Krueger identified [REDACTED], [REDACTED], [REDACTED], and [REDACTED].

A check with the Registrar office determined none of the students are dual enrolled, so they are all MCMC responsibilities. R/o requested the additional information for each student for disciplinary and reimbursement purposes. Mr. Krueger provided the requested information.

R/o spoke with Jeff VanSlambrouck, Maintenance and Grounds Foreman and Mr. VanSlambrouck advised that the base of the table is cast iron and can not be welded as a possible means of repair.

A check with Kelly Heinzerling, Director of Auxiliary Services and Purchasing determined the replacement cost for the table to be \$XXXXXX.
