The instruments are kept in a locked cabinet, padlock, in the connecting area between rooms T-122 and T-116.

The assistant professor stated that several other instructors and some students have keys to this cabinet.

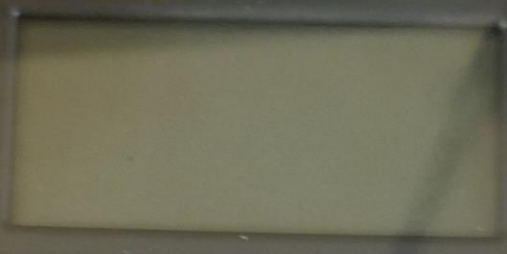
The assistant professor stated that he will keep a similar model DMM in his office for office hours with students, but he has not located the missing instrument.
