Narrative:

On Monday, 6/14/2021 R/O was made aware of a vehicle that had been dropped off on Friday 6/11/21 near the loading dock of the Life Science Building by Safety Services Officer Jeff Schmidt. According to SSO Schmidt and the MCCC Maintenance Chief, the vehicle was dropped off and was to be donated to the automotive program. According to the Maintenance Chief, the donor had been in contact with the Dean of the ASET Division to accept the vehicle for the program. SSO Jeff Schmidt spoke with the donor on Monday 6/14/21 and learned that they wanted the motor and transmission taken out of the vehicle so he could sell them. SSO Schmidt did not believe that the College handled vehicles like this and according to the Dean of the ASET Division, the donor was trying to scam the college. R/O advised SSO Schmidt that the issues would be resolved on Tuesday the following day.

The vehicle had been towed in by Mike's Garage and R/O spoke with the towing agency. All they could provide was that the vehicle had been towed from Temperance, MI from a private lot and they could not provide any contact information. R/O was unable to locate any contact information to have the donor remove the vehicle.

Absent any means to contact them, and determining the vehicle was now abandoned, R/O contacted Jim's Towing of Monroe and they arrived and took possession of the vehicle.
