INFORMATION:

On Wednesday September 23, 2020, R/O (Reporting Officer) was working as a Security Officer at Monroe County Community College. At 12:35 pm R/O received a telephone call from the Administrative Assistant in the CTC Building. Administrative Assistant reported that a student, had got his hand stuck in one of the machines in the welding shop. Student stated that he was about to pass out and there was a lot of blood. Administrative Assistant asked if she should call for an ambulance, R/O advised if it was a serious injury, go ahead and call for an ambulance. R/O responded to the CTC building and the following investigation took place.

OFFICER ACTION:

R/O located the victim by the main office in the CTC building, sitting in a chair. He was alert and conscious, but appeared to be very pale and upset. Victim had a paper towel wrapped around his right thumb. R/O advised victim that an ambulance was on the way. R/O spoke with victim about the incident (see below). R/O stayed with him until the ambulance and his mother arrived.

VICTIM:

Victim advised R/O that on today's date around 12:30 p.m., he was in his welding class, using the wire welder mig grinder. He accidentally got his right thumb stuck in the grinder, causing the injury. Once he got his thumb loose, he located the Lab Tech and showed him what happened. The Lab Tech escorted him to the main office, where he waited for R/O and the ambulance. Victim said he would be unable to drive himself to the hospital due to feeling faint. He was able to contact his mother by telephone, she later responded to the scene.

INJURY:

Right thumb appeared to be intact, but the thumbnail was torn off.
