Suspect: Subject fell off wheeled walker

Narrative:

At 10:35 hours RO (Richard Morin) was advised by Monroe County Community Health staff that an elderly female had fallen on sidewalk in front of MCCC Health Education Building (HEB).

RO responded to that location, observed subject, female, age 89, being helped back onto a 'wheeled walker' by her son and EMT, J. Lawson, and Medic, A. Howard. MCSD Deputy, R. Rosenberger, also joined RO on scene.

The son stated that as he was pushing his mother on her 'wheeled walker' the small front wheel caught edge of sidewalk tipping her onto sidewalk. He stated he had partial hold of his mother as she was falling and slowed her fall. Both he and his mother stated she had not hit her head and advised that she was not injured in any way due to the fall.

EMT Lawson and Medic Howard conducted visual exam and questioned subjects and found no observable injury and indicated that no further care was needed at that time. The son then resumed escorting his mother into HEB where subject was transferred to a proper wheel chair and continued on and completed the COVID vaccination process without further incident.

NOTE: Subjects 'wheeled walker' has very small front wheels and is not as secure as a wheelchair for transportation.
