Trespassing on MCCC property

Officer was recently advised that some “No Trespassing” signs that had been posted in the woodlot on the north/east corner of the main campus property, are actually on campus property. He was also advised by the Grounds Crew that there were indications that someone had been hunting on the north side of these signs on campus property. Upon researching the plat map of campus, it indicates the north side woodlot is campus property up to the tilled field.

On 12/13/17 Officer proceeded to the location with the Grounds Crew and the majority of the signs were removed by us. There was some deer bait on the ground and a plastic pipe style, corn feeder hanging on a tree. Officer removed the feeder and left a note on the tree advising the hunter that he can retrieve the feeder by coming to the MCCC Security office.

Officer contacted the owner of the farm property on the north side of campus. Owner advised that he had given permission to hunt his portion of the property to a subject that lives in the Carrington subdivision next door. He was very apologetic that the subject had trespassed on MCCC property and advised that he would let him know that Security has his feeder.

Prior to writing this report, Officer received a call from the property owner who again apologized for the incident and advised that he had contacted the hunter and revoked his hunting privileges. If the hunter should come to recover his feeder it is located against the far south wall in the maintenance storage garage due east of the Mechanics garage.
