On Friday, 02-09-2018 MCCC employee was plowing snow in the main parking lot (#2) of the campus. Bus driver for SMART entered the campus to the main parking lot #2 and traveled in a southeasterly direction. Victim was backing the campus' 2016 Dodge dump truck from the west side of the parking lot to continue plowing snow. R/o notes victim had the emergency flashers as well as the overhead amber lights activated. Victim was traveling easterly and SMART driver attempted to avoid the dump truck/snow plow by speeding up. The evasive action by bus driver was not sufficient and victim struck the side of the bus. Bus driver commented that she thought she could avoid the dump truck by speeding up since she did not think she could stop in time to avoid a collision.

R/o notes the weather was snowing with temperatures in the mid teens. The campus had closed due to the incimate weather and that notification was sent out at 5:07 am that morning.

Information was exchanged and the damage to the snow removal vehicle was bent back to continue snow removal and salt disbursement.
